**Calculation:**

Points are tallied for all actions rated where the member was present and voting or otherwise could have taken an action (such as sponsoring or not sponsoring a bill). After points are totaled, they are divided by the potential points a member could have earned by supporting the pro-growth position.

To account for all votes that impact spending, taxes and significant regulations, 10 points are counted for an "A" grade in the National Taxpayers Union rating of Congress, 5 points for a "B+" and 3 points for a "B". Three points were awarded if a senator did NOT sponsor S 1027, S 1254 or S 2821, three bills that could have triggered a trade war if adopted.

Senators who sponsored S 391, a big government health care bill, have 10 points deducted from their totals if they voted against ObamaCare.
